GENERAL PRICE LIST

These prices are effective as of July 7, 2021 and are subject to change without notice. The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Prior to drafting any contract for goods or services, the responsible party or the decedent's survivor who is handling the arrangements is entitled to receive a copy of any pre-need agreement, in the possession of the funeral establishment, that has been signed and paid for, in full or in part, by or on behalf of the decedent.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

Payment is due in full prior to services being rendered. We accept American Express, Visa, Discover, and MasterCard. Payment plans are also available through Affirm.

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF, AND OVERHEAD \$1,700.00

This fee for our basic services will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation). This fee includes responding to the initial request for service; conducting the arrangement conference; preparing the biographical and statistical data; preparing and filing papers, permits and authorizations; coordinating with those providing other services; and retaining and caring for remains prior to commencement of post-death activities.

DIRECT CREMATION \$1,595.00 - \$1,600.00

Includes the basic services of a funeral director and staff, the collection of the decedent from a hospital or coroner's office, nursing home or funeral home, sheltering the decedent in refrigeration for up to 5 days including the day the decedent was brought into our care, an alternative cremation container, a plastic utility urn, and the packaging and mailing of cremated remains within the US via USPS Priority Mail Express. Minnesota law does not require you to purchase a casket for cremation. If you want to arrange a cremation, you can use a cremation container. A cremation container is a combustible, closed container that encases the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or corrugated cardboard and into which a dead human body is placed prior to insertion into a cremation chamber for cremation. The containers we provide are fiberboard.

EMBALMING**\$450.00**

Except in certain cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements such as a funeral with a viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial or when refrigeration or use of dry ice is available.

Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are fiberboard.
